<b>1. Welcome &amp; Introductions</b>	<p>SWAT President, Jesus Humberto Parada welcomed everyone and attendees introduced themselves. Partnership members in attendance thanked the students for sharing their meeting a second time this year with the Tobacco Free Partnership.</p>	
<b>2. SWAT &amp; TFP Sign Ups and Activities</b>	<p>SWAT and the TFP both have an opportunity to recruit new members and interact with patrons prior to the start of the Jackie Robinson Celebration Game festivities at Historic Dodgertown on April 15th. The Partnership will provide tickets to the game and food for all SWAT and Partners who participate at the table by the entrance before the game begins. Fourteen signed up. Students will make posters to spell out anti-tobacco message to be used in the stadium at the game. They were encouraged to bring friends who may be interested in joining SWAT. Adults will gather pictures and posters from past activities to display at the table. Participants will be available to answer questions about point of sale targeting children and SWAT or the Partnership. Please arrive at 5pm. Our Partners at Historic Dodgertown will provide a table and chairs. A PSA will be announced in the stadium prior to the game urging people to sign up at the table. Everyone will think of other ways to engage people while we</p>	

	are there. There were 3,500 mostly local people in attendance last year and more are expected this year.
<b>3. Nominations for Officers</b>	Dalyce Evans, student SWAT member was appointed by Dr. Gaddis, VBHS SWAT Advisor to be the 2015-16 SWAT President. Dalyce participated in SWAT this year and for several years during middle school. Nominations for additional officer positions will be taken at the first meeting of the new school year.
<b>TFP Advisory Board</b>	The TFP Advisory Board will remain in place until the first meeting after July 1, 2015. Partners will have a chance to provide feedback on future meeting dates and times through a survey prior to June 30 <sup>th</sup> . They will consider scheduling their meetings to coincide with SWAT.
<b>4. SWAT Presentation</b>	SWAT students developed and showed a Power Point presentation focused on the effects of tobacco use and talked about personal reasons students want to participate in SWAT.
