<p>2. Old Business</p>	<p>Old Business</p> <p>a) <i>Tobacco Free Partnership Goals</i> – One of the goals, establishing SWAT at Sebastian River High School, was completed in late December. Partners prioritized and planned steps to accomplish five of the remaining goals identified earlier in the fiscal year.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stop smoking in cars with children. Partners will meet face to face with legislators; Rep. Grall and Senator Mayfield to talk about supporting a bill. Leslie will arrange the meetings and gather policy information for the Partners to share. 2. (Tied) Enforcing tobacco free policy with vendors on school grounds – Sharing good news with media. A TFP letter will be written and sent to the School Board/Superintendent requesting enforcement of tobacco free policy by vendors. It will be suggested contracts with outside vendors stipulate contracts can be terminated for violation of the policy, as IRMC does this with their vendors. Good news should highlight what is being done by Partners, property managers, and employers, to reduce exposure to tobacco use. <p>Although reducing SHS around pets and developing a fact sheet for parents are both important, time did not permit Partners to plan for the last two items.</p>	
<p>3. New Business</p>	<p>New Business</p> <p>a) A Six Months Report was distributed. These summaries are the same SWOT report submitted to the State each quarter. Leslie talked about progress with goals in quarters 1 and 2. The City of Vero Beach is putting up signage to reduce tobacco use around children. She will meet with City of Sebastian official next week to talk about upgrading signs on ballfields to include smokeless tobacco and vaping. Historic</p>	

	<p>Dodgertown is a tobacco free area. The strength of the tobacco free prevention program continues to be the support and dedication of Partnership members. Weaknesses are getting more Partners to the table and getting additional dedicated advisors for SWAT. Suggestions were to promote TFP at the cancer center with cancer support groups, and to make a presentation to the Buggy Bunch.</p>
